

Stephen:

When we have folks who come to us following such an incident, there's usually a mix of confusion, fear, anxiety and then the physical manifestations of the injury. You know any one of those things taken alone, can be overwhelming. When it's all of it all at once, it's hard for people.

Elaine C:

I feel the bang, it was shocking. When you're driving, you don't expect that on this road you take every morning. Oh god it's like my world turned over.

Stephen:

In the weeks and months following an incident, it's more about, "How do I get back on my feet? How can I get back to my life?"

Oscar G:

My life's going to be different from now. You cannot go with your kids to play anymore. It changes your life.

Stephen:

I think there's a realization that happens over time that leads to either hiring a lawyer, when you realize that none of that's going to happen on its own, and that nobody's really in your corner, other than your attorney. And so it's not enough to just prove the injuries, to just prove the incident occurred and here's the treatment that transpired afterward. What we do is we go back, we dig deeper into the clients medical history, and what we're basically trying to do is disprove the negative. We will go to that persons' employer in the years before the incident, we will go to that persons' internist or primary care doctor and we will be able to show oftentimes that what the defense is saying is simply not true. You want to say that the person had this problem before, well prove it.

Elaine C:

The way he presents himself. The way he questioned the guy. I was like, "My god he's like a pit bull-people-friendly, but punchy if you have to get punched."

Stephen:

If it means fighting with an older employer to get employment records, we'll do it. If it means developing a complex medical case to prove someones increased susceptibility to being harmed, we'll do it. Because those are the ingredients to success in a case like that.

Oscar G:

He really knows what he's doing. I will recommend him to anybody. I will do it without hesitation.
