Clients who have been the victim of police abuse also have the option of going to the CCRB, which is the Civilian Complaint Review Board. It is an entity that is separate from the police department, and they are charged with investigating allegations of police misconduct by citizens. There are positives and negatives to having our clients go to the CCRB, alongside their case, but oftentimes, our clients wish to do that because they want their voices heard. They want to get justice in every avenue possible. Oftentimes, when we have a CCRB investigation, that can help us in gathering and obtaining additional information in the case.
