Stephen Williamson:

Part of the New York No-Fault Law is a serious injury threshold requirement. And what that basically means is that not every injury from a motor vehicle accident in New York State entitles you to recover compensation and personal injury claim or lawsuit. Under the law, you have to have sustained what the law defines as a serious injury in order to recover either in a legal claim or a lawsuit for injuries from a motor vehicle accident.
